






General Fund Expenditures












Millage Renewal

On November 5, 2024, residents of Farmington and Farmington Hills will be asked to consider a 20-year renewal of the Farmington Community Library's operating millage. The November 5 ballot question will be at the rate of 0.9264 mills. This is a renewal of the current rate, not an increase. Funds levied by this millage account for 55% of the Library's total revenue on average each year.
